6. HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

- (a) The distinction of Honorary Life Membership of the Guild may be conferred by the National Executive as a mark of appreciation of especially meritorious services rendered to the Guild by such member.
- (b) Honorary Membership of the Guild may be conferred by the National Executive upon any member of at least twenty-five (25) years continuous membership, who is in good standing with the Guild, provided that such member is not actively engaged in the arranging, electronic arranging and/or copying profession. Should such member re-enter the profession, his/her Honorary Membership shall be automatically cancelled.
- (c) Long Service Honorary Membership of the Guild may be conferred by the National Executive upon any member who has at least forty (40) years continuous membership, and who is in good standing with the Guild. Such long service membership shall place no restriction on a member actively engaging as an arranger, electronic arranger and/or copyist.
- (d) Long Service Honorary Membership of the Guild may be conferred by the National Executive upon any member who has such a distinction conferred on him/her by the Musicians' Union of Australia.
- (e) The distinction of Honorary Life Membership, Distinguished Visitor may be conferred by the National Executive as a mark of respect to any visiting overseas arranger/orchestrator and/or copyist providing that during the period of his/her stay in Australia, the said visitor does not engage in any work as an arranger/orchestrator and/or copyist. Should the person then, at a later time, be employed in Australia, in any of the above categories, that person must make application to join the Guild, in accordance with the requirements of Rule 2 and 3 (c), and for the duration of that employment in Australia his/her Honorary Life Membership shall be suspended.
- (f) In the case of a member conferred with any one of the distinctions under this rule, he/she shall not be required to pay any subscriptions other than the cost of replacement stamp(s)). For the purpose of voting on any matter, or at any elections, such member shall be deemed to be financial.
