23. RIGHT OF APPEAL OF DISCIPLINED MEMEBER

- (a) A member may appeal to the Guild in General Meeting against a resolution of the National Executive which is confirmed under Rule 22 (d), within fourteen (14) days after the notice of the resolution is served on the member, by lodging with the Secretary a notice to that effect.
- (b) Upon receipt of a notice from a member under clause (a), the Secretary shall notify the National Executive, which shall convene a General Meeting of the Guild to be held within sixty (60) days after the date on which the Secretary received the notice.
- (c) At a General Meeting of the Guild convened under clause (b):
 - (i) no business other than the question of the appeal shall be transacted,
 - (ii) the National Executive and the member shall be given the opportunity to state their respective cases orally or in writing, or both; and
 - (iii) the members present shall vote by secret ballot on the question of whether the resolution should be confirmed or revoked.
- (d) If, at the General Meeting, the Guild passes a special resolution in favour of the confirmation of the resolution, the resolution is confirmed.
